Mixing the Media:

“Pop Art” re-presents the everyday articles of our society, turning the mundane into the monumental. This workshop will explore this idea by challenging students to create compositions that portray the ordinary as the extraordinary. Classes will incorporate all media necessary (drawing, watercolor, acrylic, collage, etc.) to bring the student’s own Pop Art idea to life.

Workshops cover basic composition and design, color theory, application of paint, and painting on various surfaces. Beginning Oil painting for kids

Creating Mono-prints Using Found Objects, on Fabric and Paper:

Beaded Embroidery Basics:

Learn the basics of embellishing fabric with beads. This class will cover instruction and practice of six basic stitches as well as use of various threads and fabrics to allow for greatest success in beading projects. Supplies provided.

Andrea Shreve Taylor:

Intermediate Mosaics: Intro to Installations

In this intermediate level class, students will learn the basic skills to begin creating interior or exterior mosaic art and surfaces for the home, such as backsplashes, countertops, floor insets and small scale wall murals. Using the double-direct method, students will create a 12"x18" wall panel project that will incorporate the necessary methods, skills and proper techniques required for making simple architectural installations of mosaic art. Prerequisite: Beginning Mosaics – Direct Method class, or permission instructor. Class size limited to 4. Need at least 2.
